Bradley Stoke Neighbourhood policing team have had a very busy few weeks working With other agencies and the local community.

- Pcso Jason Green has been working with St Mary's Primary school on an environmental project resulting in the cleaning up of the "Skate park" a big thanks to the school, the leisure centre for providing refreshments and prizes for a poster competition and Cllr Jon Williams for his support on the day.
- Wpc Fletcher identified 3 local offenders who graffitied Baileys court activity centre. This was dealt with by restorative justice. The offenders had to explain their actions to the people affected, in this case the town council and staff from the centre and suggest a collective resolution. The boys provided the equipment and spent 2 hours painting the centre.
- The whole team has continued its involvement in local education to explain the effects of crime and antisocial behaviour by structured talks in schools and youth organisations.

At the last Safer Stronger Community group meeting residents raised the issue of hoax e-mail's from financial institutions containing viruses. If you are ever concerned about any e-mail do not open and contact your ISP.
